

ARAUCANO RESERVA

The wines produced are vinified from grapes produced on two estate properties: the 26 hectare Lolol estate vineyard and the 15 hectare Chomedaue vineyard further down in the Colchagua Valley.

Beginning with the concept that it is possible to create world-class wines, within regions of great quality potential, brothers Jacques and Francois Lurton began several projects, first in France, then in Argentina & Spain. In 1997, after years of investigation, they founded the JFL Chile partnership, Hacienda Araucano, within the Lolol area of the Colchagua Valley.

The wines produced are vinified from grapes produced on the estate and as well as grapes bought from viticulturists, who sign specific contracts for high quality production under strict vineyard management from the Lurton viticultural team. Most red wines are produced from grapes from the Colchagua Valley, while some of the white wine is sourced from grapes from the Casablanca Valley, known for having a great microclimate for the production of white wine grapes.

Since their introduction to the US markets, Hacienda Araucano wines have been an overnight success. It is no surprise that the so-called "flying wine makers" would create excellent wines from Chile. Their concept of producing world-class wines in countries and areas of great potential still holds true and they are consistently bringing exceptional wines to the market.

Today, the company operates in four countries as Domaines François Lurton.

The palate is medium-bodied with grainy tannins. A well made commercial Cabernet Sauvignon."



"Woodsy, spicy aromas of herbal plum and berry come with a light coating of chocolate. A round, rubbery palate is tight in the long run. Saturated plum and blackberry flavors are oaky in front of an extracted finish that runs long and doesn't hold back. Drink through 2022."

2014 "Cool black-fruit aromas are solid, a bit oaky and show nothing that's unnecessary. A fully extracted palate with moderately hard tannins is where you'll find herbal black-fruit flavors along with tobacco and spice notes. A dry finish is firm and peppery. Drink through 2023."

"This is a juicy blend of carmenere, syrah and cabernet franc with a touch of cabernet sauvignon and petit verdot. Gran Araucano Cabernet Sauvignon 2014

Beautiful, very deep red robe with cherry glints. Very aromatic nose, characterized by intense fruit, with fresh blackcurrants and complex notes of thyme and garrigue. Powerful on the palate, coated with concentrated tannins, that nevertheless show great finesse. The finish is very long, full-flavored and complex.

Alka Carmenere 2014

"The top of the range is a pure Carmenere, the 2014 Alka, which is sourced 50% from their Lolol vineyard and 50% from vines in Apalta. It's a ripe and heady version of the grape, with high alcohol, full-bodied and with some sweetness in the finish. It matured in 600-liter French oak barrels for 18 months. It follows the house style of ripe wines with a commercial profile. Drink 2017-2022."

"Alka typically delivers size and oak, and this vintage shows a thick coating of oak on top of herbal cassis and blackberry scents. A concentrated, lively palate is bright in acidity, while oaky, savory flavors of balsamic berry fruits and chocolate finish baked, spicy, bold and chewy. Drink through 2023."

2015 "Fully ripe aromas of animal hide and dark-berry fruits blend with heavy oak notes that are borderline chemical and like paint. Drink through 2025.."
