Over the past 20 years, the Römerhof winery has established long-term contracts with select growers who are advised to cultivate vineyards under exacting standards with restricted yields and specific harvest times. Fermentation takes place in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks. All wines are then tasted and blended by a committee of oenologists and sommeliers. All production takes place in an ISO standard certified bottling plant and the wines are stored in modern climate-controlled warehouses.

Producing top quality German Riesling is more than just a science, it is an art. This vision is deeply rooted at Römerhof and extends throughout the Eifel family. Heinz Eifel Rieslings are a true testament to "The Art of German Winemaking."

Heinz Eifel Beerenauslese 2009

The Heinz Eifel Beerenauslese (literally meaning: “select-ed harvest of berries”) is a wine made from hand selected grapes. It is often called “ba” for short, and is usually made from grapes affected by noble rot, a very rare condition in the grapes allowing for the production of highly concentrated flavors and sweetness.

“Clear yellow gold with a slight green tinge, this 100% Silvaner wine shows aromas and flavors of ripe pear and peach and botrytis on a medium weight palate with a slight bitterness on the mid-palate that carries over to a lightly sweet finish.”
