2014 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Zuccardi Q Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from select vineyard lots in Gualtallary, Tupungato (4035 ft) and La Consulta (3608 ft), Uco Valley. The front label image illustrates the stone walls of the Zuccardi winery rising from the Uco Valley soils symbolizing how the Andes mountains emerged millions of years ago.

WINE DATA:

GRAPE COMPOSITION: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

APPELLATION: La Consulta, Uco Valley, Mendoza and Gualtallary, Tupungato, Uco Valley, Mendoza

ALCOHOL: 14.5% TOTAL ACIDITY: 6.23 g/l RESIDUAL SUGAR: 2.00 g/l

VINIFICATION: Selection of grape bunches with gravity filled tanks. Fermented with indigenous yeast with a soft extraction by delestage and pigeage. Maceration in skin with malolactic fermentation for 25 days. Aging in French oak barrels (first, second and third use) for 25 days. Maturation in combination of French and American medium toasted oak barrels for one year.

TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Intense purple color.

AROMA: Great intensity with ripe red and black fruits notes such as blueberry and cassis along with some black pepper notes.

FLAVOR: Full-bodied with firm, mature and integrated tannins. Very long and persistent finish.
