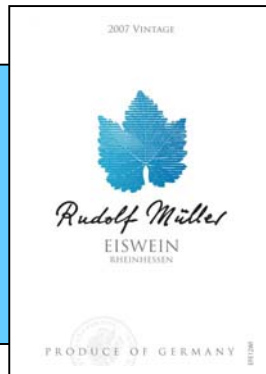

Source:	The Rosenbühl vineyard is located in the southern part of the Pfalz region in the village of Freinsheim. Early seasons and earlier ripening in a constant and relatively warm climate are key factors for producing well-developed grapes. The frosty nights in early autumn helped harvest the Eiswein in the best possible condition
Flavor:	This amazing sweet white wine has a pepper-laced pear and apple nose and offers eye-popping acidity, loads of depth and a long, sweet finish.
Food Affinities:	Its light sweetness makes it a perfect match with aged cheeses, chicken and veal with cream sauces and spicier cuisine. Also try with desserts based on dairy and/or fruits such as cheesecake or ice cream with fresh berries, apple pie a la mode and zabayon.
