An evolution of Zuccardi Zeta

Sebastian Zuccardi made this wine in honor of his father, José Alberto Zuccardi. Created in a more traditional style, the wine symbolizes José's passion for his wine family, his commitment to quality and his conviction for mountain wines.

WINE DATA

GRAPE COMPOSITION: 90% Malbec, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon

ORIGIN: A blend from the calcareous soils of Paraje Altamira & Gualtallary vineyards in the Uco Valley.

- Paraje Altamira 1100 mts / 3608 ft

The area has very special characteristics: wide heterogeneity of soils, cool weather, temperature range and a constant breeze that promotes healthy grapes.

- Gualtallary 1360 mts / 4460 ft

It is characterized by extreme cold and dry climate with large temperature range. Presence of heterogeneous, calcareous and alluvial soils.

VINIFICATION: Selection of bunches. Concrete vats filled by gravity and fermentation with indigenous yeasts. Macerated for 20 days with daily delestage and pigeage. The wine was aged in oak barrels and concrete vessels. Bottled unfiltered.

ALCOHOL: 14.5% TOTAL ACIDITY: 5.93 G/L RESIDUAL SUGAR: 2.02 G/L

TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Intense red black

AROMA: Complex nose that highlights ripe black and red fruit aromas; subtle spicy notes.

FLAVOR: Firm and mature tannins that give structure to the wine. Fresh and elegant due to great acidity. Long finish.
