WINE DATA:

GRAPE COMPOSITION: 100% Cabernet Franc

APPELLATION: San Pablo, Valle de Uco, Mendoza

VINIFICATION: Maceration done in concrete vats (no epoxy) with indigenous yeast. Maceration for 20 days. The wine was aged in 2500 liters foudres.

ALTITUDE: 4,265 ft / 1,300 mt above sea level

SOIL TYPE: Alluvial soil well stratified. Small middle eroded stone on a sandy-clay layer

ALCOHOL: 13% | TOTAL ACIDITY 5.85 g/l | RESIDUAL SUGAR 1.80 g/l

TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Red color with violet hues.

AROMA: Expresses a great herbal character with notes of fresh red fruits.

FLAVOR: Lively acidity and subtlety of tannins in the mouth.
