

Polígonos of the Uco Valley is a selection that expresses the particular characteristics of different terroirs within the Valley. These are wines from a selection of vineyards that account for the differences in altitude, soil and climate that currently characterize the subregions of San Pablo, Paraje Altamira and Tupungato.

GRAPE COMPOSITION: 100% Verdejo

APPELLATION: San Pablo, Valle de Uco, Mendoza

VINIFICATION: Vinified with direct pressing. Fermented with indigenous yeasts in concrete pools and has aging without malolactic fermentation in concrete.

ALTITUDE: 4,593 ft / 1,400 mt above sea level

SOIL TYPE: Soils of alluvial origin, sandy loams of medium depth with medium gravels covered with limestone.

ALCOHOL: 13.3% | TOTAL ACIDITY: 5.8 g/l | RESIDUAL SUGAR: 2.0 g/l

TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Greenish hue.

AROMA: On the nose somewhat austere. With freshness and some lemon-style citrus. FLAVOR: Well-rounded acidity, some citrus, optra time lemon and lime and fresh.
