## WINE DATA:

GRAPE COMPOSITION: 100\% Malbec
APPELLATION: Gualtallary, Valle de Uco, Mendoza
VINIFICATION: Fermented and aged in concrete vats (no epoxy) with indigenous yeast. Maceration for 20 days. Aging in concrete and in 500lt oak barrels.

ALTITUDE: 4,265 ft / 1,300 mt above sea level
SOIL TYPE: Alluvial, with grains of gravel covered with calcium carbonate at a shallow depth, caliche and calcareous sands ALCOHOL: $14 \%$ | TOTAL ACIDITY $5.78 \mathrm{~g} / /$ | RESIDUAL SUGAR $1.80 \mathrm{~g} / \mathrm{l}$

## TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Red color with violet hues.
AROMA: Expresses a great herbal character with notes of fresh red fruits.
FLAVOR: Lively acidity and subtlety of tannins in the mouth.
