WINE DATA:

GRAPE COMPOSITION: 100% Malbec

APPELLATION: Paraje Altamira, Valle de Uco, Mendoza

WINEMAKING: Maceration done in concrete vats (no epoxi) with indigenous yeast.

Maceration for 20 days. The wine was aged in concrete vats.

ALTITUDE: 3,600 ft / 1,100 mt above sea level

SOIL TYPE: Alluvial soil well stratified. 4" to 32" deep soil over big-clay-covered stones.

ALCOHOL: 13 % | TOTAL ACIDITY 5.85 g/l | RESIDUAL SUGAR 1.80 g/l

TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Red color with violet hues.

AROMA: Expresses a great herbal character with notes of fresh red fruits.

FLAVOR: Lively acidity and subtlety of tannins in the mouth.
