WINEMAKING: Maceration done in concrete vats (no epoxi) with indigenous yeast.

Maceration for 20 days. The wine was aged in concrete vats.

ALTITUDE: 3,600 ft / 1,100 mt above sea level

 $SOILTYPE: Alluvial\ soil\ well\ stratified.\ 4"\ to\ 32"\ deep\ soil\ over\ big-clay-covered\ stones.$
