## ZUCCARDI POLÍGONOS *San Pablo Malbec 2017*

### WINE DATA:

GRAPE COMPOSITION: 100% Malbec

APPELLATION: San Pablo, Valle de Uco, Mendoza

VINIFICATION: Maceration done in concrete vats (no epoxy) with indigenous yeast. Maceration for 20 days. The wine was aged in concrete vats.

ALTITUDE: 4,593 ft / 1,400 mt above sea level

SOIL TYPE: Alluvial, sandy - loamy, with layers of gravel covered with calcium carbonate at variable depth

ALCOHOL: 13 % | TOTAL ACIDITY 5.60 g/l | RESIDUAL SUGAR 1.80 g/l

### TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Red color with violet hues.

AROMA: Expresses a great herbal character with notes of fresh red fruits.

FLAVOR: Lively acidity and subtlety of tannins in the mouth.
