WINE DATA:

GRAPE COMPOSITION: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

APPELLATION: La Carrera, Tupungato, Valle de Uco, Mendoza

VINIFICATION: Maceration of 10 days on the skins. Fermentation and aging in concrete vessels.

ALTITUDE: 4,920 ft / 1,500 mt above sea level

SOIL PROFILE: Very complex alluvial soils, with deposits of small fans born between the Cordillera Frontal and the Sierra del Totoral. Heterogeneous, with a normally frank texture, and occasionally with a higher content of organic matter. At varying depths there are layers of small gravels. ALCOHOL: 12.5% | TOTAL ACIDITY: 9.19 g/l | RESIDUAL SUGAR: 2.0 g/l

TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Greenish hue. AROMA: Stone fruit and citrus zest on the nose. FLAVOR: Off dry with refreshing herbal notes. Soft acidity, fresh and well rounded.
