The Zuccardi 'Q' line represent wines of the highest quality made from the oldest vines, up to 40 years of age, grown at the foot of the Andes Mountains in the high altitude province of Valle de Uco of Mendoza. The rich climate and geography of our high elevation Valle de Uco vineyards provide excellent fruit ripening and concentration.

Zuccardi Q 2023 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Zuccardi Q Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from select vineyard lots in Gualtallary, Tupungato (4035 ft) and La Consulta (3608 ft), Uco Valley. It has intense purple color and is full of ripe red black fruit aromas, such as blueberries and cassis. It can be consumed now, but will age beautifully for several years. The front label image illustrates the stone walls of the Zuccardi winery rising from the Uco Valley soils symbolizing how the Andes mountains emerged millions of years ago.

WINE DATA:

GRAPE COMPOSITION: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

APPELLATION: La Consulta, Uco Valley, Mendoza (3608 ft / 1100 meters) and Gualtallary, Tupungato, Uco Valley, Mendoza (4035 ft / 1250 meters).

ALCOHOL: 14.0% | TOTAL ACIDITY: 5.9 g/l | RESIDUAL SUGAR: 1.93 g/l

VINIFICATION: Selection of bunches. Tanks filled by gravity. Fermented with indigenous yeast with a soft extraction by *delestage* and *pigeage*. Skin maceration after fermentation for 25 days. Malolactic fermentation and oak aging.

TASTING NOTES:

COLOR: Intense purple color with red hues.

AROMA: Great aromatic intensity with ripe red and black notes.

FLAVOR: Great structure and long finish.
