The Heinz Eifel Beerenauslese (literally meaning LOCATION 'selected harvest of berries') is a wine from hand selected grapes. It is often called "ba" for short and is usually made from grapes affected by noble rot, a very rare condition in the grapes allowing for the production of highly concentrated flavors and sweetness. This wine has aromas and flavors of honey and caramelized fruit. It is produced in very small quantity and only when the weather and vineyard have suitable conditions. It may be enjoyed with aged cheeses and other complimentary desserts.



VARIETAL

100% Bacchus

Bacchus is a grape variety used for white wine. The Bacchus grape is a white hybrid grape variety, created by viticulturalist Peter Morio at the Geilweilerhof Institute for Grape Breeding in the Palatinate in 1933. It is a cross between Silvaner-Riesling and Müller-Thurgau. Bacchus can reach high must weights, and has no high requirement for sites it can be planted and can grow where Riesling does not ripen reliably. Bacchus wines are highly aromatic, known for distinct floral and fruity notes, including elderflower, jasmine, grapefruit, passion fruit, and peach.
