



Having managed the estate since 1987, Stefan Bollig is a fine example of the new generation of Mosel vintners. The family has been producing wine since the 17th Century and the 10 acres are tended by the family themselves. Their very steep sloped vineyard sites are composed mainly of blue and black decomposing slaty soil. Dedications to the estate and costly investments have achieved a high standard of quality.

Irresistible in youth but concentrated enough to drink well through 2025, at least."
