



Carlos Serres was a pioneer in Rioja. In 1896 he established one of the first wineries in Haro, the wine capital of Rioja. He was an instrumental figure in promoting the early exports of Rioja wines. Today, the Bodega remains family-owned and operated and is one of only a few centenarian producers in Rioja. The estate is just southeast of Haro and spreads out over nearly 150 acres of premium Rioja Alta vineyards with vines average 30+ years old. Bodega Carlos Serres sets out to remain one of the most internationally-renowned and influential wineries in Spain.

100% Tempranillo

"Old Vines" was banned from the names in the wines, so with the change of image toward more tradition, they also looked for organic grapes to produce a new 2020 Tempranillo Ecológico. It had a short aging in barrel to keep a young and fresh profile, juicy with some spices, with medium ripeness, 13.5% alcohol and a polished, soft palate. Drink 2022 - 2027."

"Deep garnet. Oak-spiced cherry and subtle floral and herb qualities on the nose and palate. In a forward, jammy style, showing good depth and cling on the warm, subtly tannic finish. Drinking window 2021-2025."

2015 "Brilliant red. Aromas of fresh red berries, vanilla and baking spices show very good clarity and lift. Silky, focused and energetic on the palate, offering sweet cherry and raspberry flavors that deepen slowly on the back half. Finishes juicy, precise and quite long, featuring a touch of smokiness and gentle tannins that sneak in late. Drinking window 2020-2026."

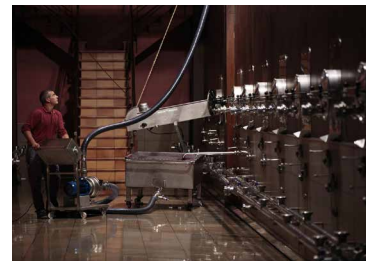

Rioja Reserva 2015/16

90% Tempranillo, 10% Graciano

"The classical, sleek and polished 2014 Reserva was produced with a blend of Tempranillo with 10% Graciano from their El Estanque estate vineyards. The grapes fermented separately and matured in French and American oak barrels for 18 months. The nose has it all—the ripe berries, the forest floor, the sweet spices, the balsamic incense and cigar ash—all in harmony and integration. The palate is medium-bodied with resolved tannins and good balance, lively and tasty, almost salty. Great price too."

Rioja Gran Reserva 2012

85% Tempranillo, 10% Graciano, 5% Mazuelo

"Each variety is aged separately for 36 months in American and French oak and then aged an additional 36 months in bottle. Aromas and flavors of chocolate-cherry-plum meld with a deep coat of licorice, for a velvet-lined mouthfeel. Sandalwood on the finish reveals a savory spice."

"Vivid garnet. Cherry pit, red currant, cigar box, coconut and floral qualities on the fragrant nose. Smooth and expansive on the palate, offering appealingly sweet red fruit, candied rose, cola and licorice flavors and a building vanilla quality. Closes long and spicy, with a repeating cherry note and supple tannins that lend discreet grip. Drink 2021-2029."

Brut 2019

47% Viura, 35% Chardonnay, 18% Tempranillo Blanco

All the grapes are supplied by an exclusive group of growers from different towns in Rioja Alta with whom the winery has long-term agreements. The Alta subregion benefits from a climate with a marked Atlantic influence, ideal for the production of high-quality sparkling wines, as the fruit displays low pH and is perfect for aging. The vines are, on average 10-25 years old. The winery jointly manages them to ensure the utmost fruit quality, with continuous monitoring during the growing cycle.

"A new sparkling wine from Carlos Serres, the 2019 Brut was produced with an unusual blend of 47% Viura, 35% Chardonnay and 18% Tempranillo Blanco that refermented in bottle and was kept with the lees for 19 months in bottle and adjusted to nine grams of sugar. It has a leesy nose and some bubbles, acidity and sugar that might need a little more time in bottle to settle. Drink 2022 - 2024."
