



The "Faisão" (pheasant) is native to Asia, but was brought to Portugal by merchants in the middle ages. It is an exquisite bird with brightly colored feathers and unique beauty that gives inspiration to our wines. The grapes for our wines are grown in the following regions: Vinho Verde, the largest Portuguese wine region located in the northwest of Portugal, the Tejo region, located in the heart of Portugal, and toward the north of the city of Lisbon lies the Lisboa region, with rolling hills that stretch along the Atlantic coast.
