The Estate is remote coastal and rugged terroir - this produces distinctively bold, ripe fruit flavors, and exquisitely expressive wines. The soil found here in the Awatere Valley is alluvial gravels that rise through our silt and clay soils - delivering bold minerality, intensity and ripe opulence to our wines.
