Fritz Zimmer Riesling is made from grapes harvested on the sloping hillsides of Germany's prime wine growing regions. The winding rivers running alongside these vineyards reflect sunlight, which help to ripen the grapes throughout the long cool growing season.



This Riesling is slightly sweet with bright, crisp flavors of green apple, pear and peach.
