



ORIGINS

After more than a century, today the winery is sold in 48 markets across the world and is well-known for the production of classic Piedmontese wines as an expression of its territory of origin: a unique land dedicated to the production of wine excellence that blends well with the great cultural and gastronomic tradition of the region.

RICOSSA WINERY

The Winery is located in Castel Boglione - halfway between the town of Acqui Terme and Nizza Monferrato - and was built in 2004, at the middle of the estate. The estate is made up of 350 acres, of which 150 acres dedicated to the cultivation of vines, located in the heart of the Nizza DOCG production area.

These vineyards are planted with Barbera and Moscato for both Asti appellation wines as well as the Barbera appassimento. They sit on the southern side of the valley, positioned in one of two deep amphitheater like settings and are considered one of the finest positions for sun exposure. Below the estate you find the Bogliona stream, which offers a steady supply of water to the surrounding soil. The soil consists of silt and marl as well as clay in some areas. The unique powder-like consistency gives the possibility for good drainage of excess water as well as holding it deep in the soil as a reserve for dry periods. Sourcing from the other appellations is carefully selected from a select group of growers/vineyards with whom the Ricossa has first right of refusal each vintage.
