

Gran Araucano Cabernet Sauvignon 2018

"Red plums, blackberries, dried herbs, chocolate and toasted nuts on the nose. It's full-bodied with firm, dusty tannins. Structured with concentrated, ripe dark fruit and spice. Flavorful finish with length. Drink or hold."

A little less might have been more. A blend of 41 per cent carmenere, 30 per cent syrah, 17 per cent cabernet sauvignon and 12 per cent cabernet franc. From biodynamically grown grapes. Demeter certified."
