LA MANCHA

The high altitude arid plains of La Mancha have a continental climate – cold, snowy winters, drenched with sunlight and drastic diurnal summer temperatures with nearly zero precipitation. The soils are very sandy and are intermixed with pure chalk and red clay, evening out the precious moisture for the vines. These harsh conditions result in rich red wines.

VOLVER Cuvée Tempranillo-Cabernet Sauvignon 2018/20

"Sourced from a single vineyard planted in 1957, this inky violet-colored blend of Tempranillo and Cabernet Sauvignon has aromas of black cherry, blueberry, milk chocolate and nutmeg. It is both spicy and juicy on the palate, with flavors of eucalyptus, anise, blackberry and raspberry and notes of milk chocolate and roasted fennel, all wrapped in firm tannins that melt away into a gentle finish."

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ALICANTE

A slightly tempered Continental climate with Mediterranean influences. Winters are cold, with snow in the higher elevations. The soil is dry and shallow, and is primarily composed of limestone, which is the mother rock. The soil is intermixed with large chunks of pure chalk. The largest marble quarry in Europe is located near our vineyards, testament to the chalky quality of the soils. Marble is the product of chalk, or calcium carbonate, that has been compressed over a very long period of time.

Brilliant golden color. In the nose we find notes of ripe fruit, pineapple, mango, peach and honey as well as hints of vanilla and spices as it passes through the barrel. In the mouth it is tasty, balanced with good acidity. Intense finish.

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TIERRA DE CASTILLA Harsh, arid, continental climate with cold winters that see snow. During the summer, the temperature fluctuates drastically between day and night. The soils are very sandy and are intermixed with pure chalk and red clay.

ALMANSA, JUMILLA, VALENCIA Less extreme climate than in La Mancha, but summers are very hot. The soil is rich in limestone, alternating areas of land with stones and little substrate with more sandy and deep areas. These conditions permit us to obtain wines with lots of flavor and color intensity.



WRONGO DONGO
Monastrel-Jumilla 2020

Intense cherry color with aromas of ripe fruit, spices and chocolate. Vivid with a remarkable, fruity and balanced acidity, surprisingly elegant and fresh, with raspberry flavors, cherries, red currants and endless persistence. Medium bodied with a long finish.

Bobal 2021

Brilliant ruby colour. In the nose crystallized fruit, sweet and subtly toasted spices thanks to the time spent in the barrel. Medium intensity in the mouth with a balanced tannin.

Young, powerful and fruity red wine. Intense ripe red fruit on the nose and sweet on the palate due to the warmth of this vintage.

VENTA MORALES Organic
Tempranillo 2021

Intense and dark cherry-red color, with a high robe and ruby red edges. Clean and bright. Highly intense aromas with abundant notes of fruit. Its notes of red and black fruit (prunes, figs, cherries, redcurrant and raspberries) are released along with flower notes and mixed with nice spicy and light toasted nuances. High load of fruit aromas dominate the palate. It is a lively and crisp, medium-bodied red wine. It shows a light astringency provided by its marked tannins and a good acidity that provides it with deepness. Long and persistent finish.
