



In 1860, Prosper Maufoux, who was a notary by trade, left his practice to give his life over to his passion for wine. In 1970, his grandson, Pierre, brought Prosper Maufoux's headquarters to the main square in Santenay. Now at the winemaking helm is Eric Piffault, whose family's roots in Burgundian wine go back to 1898. Oenologist Nadine Gublin is now on board, overseeing the production of the house.

**Domaine Vigne Au Roy Hautes Cotes de Nuit Rouge 2020**

*"At once ripe, with fresh sour-cherry fruit, the nose also has a touch of wet earth in the fall. Impressive depth for this humble appellation, the acidity riper than is often case here, the gentle tannins neatly interlocking with this. No hero, but a delightful wine that gives plenty of Burgundy character for a modest price. Sustainable. Drink now."*

*"Originally a site for sparkling wine, this vineyard is now producing tart, berry-scented pinot noir. GRAND VIN DE BOURGOGNE



**Château de Saint-Aubin 1er Premier Cru Clos du Château Monopole 2018**

*"A ripe and generous wine for this cool-climate appellation, with medium body that feels fuller, due to the considerable creaminess (from sur-lie maturation) on the palate. Plenty of ripe-pear character, plus touches of candied lemon, coconut and ground almonds. Long, chalky finish with crisp acidity and good freshness for the vintage. Drink now."*

**2020** *"The first impression on the nose is of caramelized tree fruit and flint, but this Saint-Aubin is still very young. On the palate all the elements we expect for this appellation are there, from the salty minerality to the restrained lemon and crisp pear fruit. Well-structured with excellent freshness for this warm vintage. Only at the long, stony finish do you feel the oak a bit, but these are early days for a wine made to age. Drinkable now, but best from 2024."*
