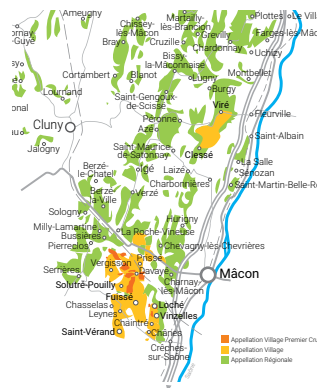


GEORGES

DOMAINE BÉRANGER POUILLY-FUISSE

For more than four centuries, the Duboeuf family has been producing wine. Now, Georges Duboeuf is a name that needs no introduction, as he is famous for turning Beaujolais Nouveau into an international phenomenon. He loved the Beaujolais region and wines, and his dedication still resonates today - elevating both the Beaujolais region and Gamay grape to near-cult status. The family passion for fine wine lives today in Duboeuf's top-level bottlings of single domaines, representing the best and most iconic wines of the Beaujolais and Maconnais regions.



DOMAINE

Founded in 1838, Domaine Béranger has been owned by the Béranger family for generations. For more than 200 years, the family has lived in the hamlet of Pouilly, in the commune of Solutré, an area once known as the "Béranger District." Renowned for producing exceptional Pouilly-Fuisse, the domaine has partnered with Georges Duboeuf for more than 40 years, with Duboeuf purchasing the estate's entire production for many years.



VINEYARD

Viticulture: The 5-acre vineyard is situated at an elevation of 820 feet (250 meters) and is planted on clay-limestone soils. This exceptional terroir provides ideal conditions for Chardonnay, producing wines of richness, minerality, and elegance.



Winemaking: The grapes are gently pressed using a direct press before fermenting at 64–68°F (18–20°C). The wine undergoes malolactic fermentation and is aged on its fine lees, with 30% matured in new oak barrels and the remainder in stainless steel tanks.



TASTING
NOTES

A brilliant pale gold color with light green tints. The nose is very complex and shows great finesse, combining white blossom, hazelnut, roasted almond, pear and lime blossom aromas. A rich, fleshy wine with a long, elegant finish.
