It's a blend of Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca and Tinta Roriz that matured in stainless steel and has a moderate 13.5% alcohol. Drink Date: 2024 - 2028."

"A fragrant overtone of milled pepper, paprika and sandalwood aromas offers an enticing entry point for this suave, medium-bodied red. Layers limber, sculpted tannins and lively acidity over a focused core of ripe mulberry, black plum, violet and shiso leaf notes. Long and loamy on the finish. Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz and Touriga Franca. Drink now through 2031."

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La Rosa Reserva Red 2021

"The 2021 La Rosa Grande Reserva Red is a modern, ripe and generously oaked Douro red with elegance, balance and the 2021 freshness. It is powerful and elegant, with stuffing, freshness and balance to develop nicely in bottle. It was produced exclusively with Touriga Nacional and Touriga Franca that fermented in granite pools and oak vats and matured in French oak barrels, 40% of them new, for 20 months. It might need a little more time to get the oak more integrated. Drink Date: 2026 - 2034."

"Black and red cherry fruit on the nose alongside cloves and licorice. Chocolate and cedar too. It's creamy and full-bodied with velvety tannins and a long, polished finish. Mostly touriga nacional and touriga franca. Drink now or hold."

2020 *"A polished red, with base notes of garrigue and minerals supporting lush black currant and plum sauce fruit flavors. Medium- to full-bodied and harmonious, showing good cut from the limber, sculpted tannins and lively acidity. Tar and spice accents lace the lingering finish. Drink now through 2034."*

"The 2019 Reserva is 40% Old Vines, 30% Touriga Nacional and 30% Touriga Franca, aged for 20 months in 50% new French oak. It comes in at 14.5% alcohol. A beauty, this is a graceful red with both freshness and intensity of flavor. It also shows admirable mid-palate finesse, concentration of fruit without being jammy, and ripe tannins. The finish is nuanced with dry blueberries and plums. This is surprisingly approachable now, but it is still undeveloped and in need of a couple of years of cellaring for best results. It is one of those refined, old-school offerings that has a certain understatement. You won't go "wow," but the bottle will empty quickly at the table."

"This is aromatic with lemon rind, honeysuckle, beeswax and stones. Sleek and creamy with mellow fruit. Citrus and golden apples. Zest and crushed herbs on the finish. Drink now."

"This is attractive with notes of walnut, dried cherries and chocolate. Some toffee, too. Full-bodied with fine tannins and velvety texture. The tannin structure and earthy character balances the sweetness and leads to a chalky finish. Drink now."

Vintage Port 2016

"This is a finely perfumed wine with swathes of ripe berry fruits and a generous texture. A dry style of vintage, it emphasizes spice, the bite of the spirit as well as the opulent black-plum and raisin fruit flavors. There is great potential in this fine wine. Drink from 2027."

"Rather nicely concentrated in terms of fruit flavor, this beautifully balanced Porto also has moderately ripe tannins, velvet for texture and a persistent finish. It coats the palate and delivers intense flavor on that finish, while the fruit is always lifted. Then, the tannins take over as the fruit recedes. Several days later, it was still drinking beautifully and it was surprisingly persistent, concluding with controlled tannic pop. The tannins may be ripe, but there are plenty of them. It took several days to open up again and become expressive again. There's plenty here to like, beginning with its enticing freshness and ending with the fact that it is delicious. Drink 2026-2065."

Vintage 2017 *"Very floral in profile, with violet and lilac accents leading off, followed by a decidedly red-fruit spectrum of raspberry, cherry and red currant coulis flavors that race throughout. Has grip, but this is more reliant on acidity, showing a nearly piercing feel as the tightly focused finish zips along, leaving a mouthwatering impression. Best from 2033 through 2050."*

"Wonderfully aromatic and filled with flavor, this got plenty of aeration and didn't blink even a little. It was still vibrant and expressive. Aeration only made it more tannic. It is also delicious. This is potentially a great Port, and it seems like the best I've seen from La Rosa. This is sort of approachable in the near future, but it really needs (at least) a decade of cellaring. It has a lot of muscle and should age well."
