Our wild, wind-swept Otuwhero Estate is set at the edge of the Southern Pacific Ocean. The Estate is remote coastal and rugged terroir – this produces distinctively bold, ripe fruit flavors, and exquisitely expressive wines. The soil found here in the Awatere Valley is alluvial gravels that rise through our silt and clay soils – delivering bold minerality, intensity and ripe opulence to our wines.

"A vibrant cherry color, this needs swirling in the glass to open but soon reveals a nose of brambly red fruit, savory spice, dried flowers and a hint of meatiness along a spine of dusty cola oak. The palate is light- to medium-bodied and has an appealing crunch of acidity, softly silky, tangy red berries and a gentle but well-structured tug of chalky, spicy tannins. Drink now and over the next few years."

OTU Limited Release Sauvignon Blanc 2024

"Sauvy B's characteristic flint and green herbal pungency is on full display, but then it rushes the fruit—lime, grapefruit, passionfruit—to balance the scales. There's more pungency, emphasized by a big lift of acidity and well-tucked fruit, on the palate but enough textural weight to prop it up. Sip with a summer salad or roasted poblano peppers."
