"Beaujolais-Villages Nouveau is Beaujolais Nouveau's quiet, more-attractive sibling. Muddled red cherry and boysenberry aromas lift from the glass along with apricot skin and black plum. Grippy tannins lead on the attack and resolve in red currant and rosehip on the elongated finish."

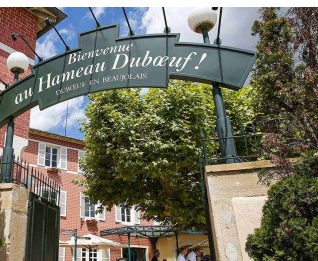
Georges Dubœuf Beaujolais Nouveau 2025

"Beaujolais Nouveau is a celebration of the newest French vintage, and this bottling lives up to the pressure of first to bat. Fragrant aromas of pomegranate, red cherry, white peach skin and hibiscus open on the nose that is dusted with violet blossom. The palate has more concentration than one typically expects from a Nouveau which is a pleasant surprise along with sturdy tannins that parse the finish in equal measure."

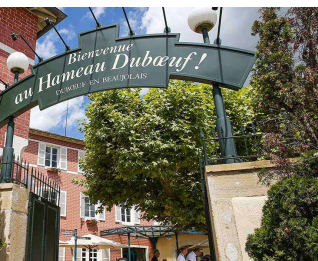

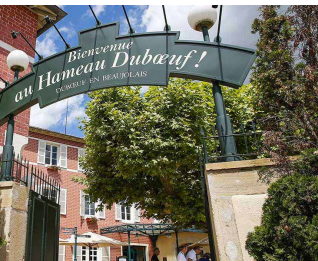

Georges Dubœuf Chardonnay

This wine offers aromas of fresh exotic fruits, acacia honey, peach, citrus and vanilla. It is smooth and creamy, with a clean finish.

Georges Dubœuf Pinot Noir

It exudes aromas of red fruits, especially cherry and wild strawberry. With an elegant and luscious mouth-feel, the fruit forward palate has notes of spice from a subtle touch of French oak. Unctuous and delicious through the finish.

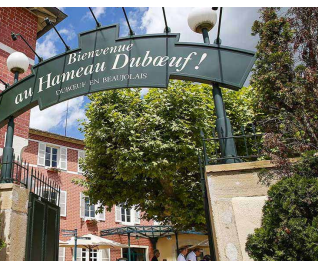


Georges Dubœuf Cabernet Sauvignon

Georges Dubœuf Domaine les Chenevieres Mâcon-Villages 2022

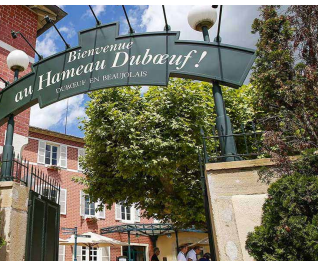
"Complex, perfumed aromas waft from the glass and encircle the nose beginning with freshly-baked brioche followed by candied red apple, caramel and dried field grass. The palate is firm and fulsome with weighty orchard fruit that soothes on the finish punctuated by moments of tart acidity that refresh the senses."

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Georges Dubœuf Chateau de Saint Amour Saint Amour

Bright garnet-red color. Intense and complex nose with aromas of ripe black fruits, such as morello cherry and blackberry, completed with flower hints (rose). Mouth is extraordinarily rich and chewy. A generous and heady wine, with silky and fat tannins. Very long finish.

Georges Dubœuf Jean Descombes Morgon Côte Du Py

Brilliant purple color. After a little airing this very powerful wine has a nose that opens on notes of cherries kirch, licorice but also notes of violets. The mouth of a beautiful concentration evolves gently with round and delicate tannins. A very pleasant Morgon but with a very good ageing potential.

Georges Dubœuf Domaine des Rosiers Moulin a Vent

A garnet color with purplish tints. This wine is characterised by intense dark berry aromas (blackcurrants, blackberries) with floral scents such as peonies, sustained by a hint of spice. Its tannins have great finesse, giving the wine power and elegance. Superb length.

Brilliant blueberry color. A charming cuvée with aromas of black cherry marmalade enhanced by notes of white pepper. Powerful, rich, full-bodied, heady, with solid tannin and a long, lingering finish. It's got character, but no lack of elegance.
