ALICANTE

A slightly tempered Continental climate with Mediterranean influences. Winters are cold, with snow in the higher elevations. The soil is dry and shallow, and is primarily composed of limestone, which is the mother rock. The soil is intermixed with large chunks of pure chalk. The largest marble quarry in Europe is located near our vineyards, testament to the chalky quality of the soils. Marble is the product of chalk, or calcium carbonate, that has been compressed over a very long period of time.

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TARIMA

TIERRA DE CASTILLA Harsh, arid, continental climate with cold winters that see snow. During the summer, the temperature fluctuates drastically between day and night. The soils are very sandy and are intermixed with pure chalk and red clay.

ALMANSA, JUMILLA, VALENCIA Less extreme climate than in La Mancha, but summers are very hot. The soil is rich in limestone, alternating areas of land with stones and little substrate with more sandy and deep areas. These conditions permit us to obtain wines with lots of flavor and color intensity.

"Very ripe and spicy nose with some coffee, dates, charred spices and pine trees to the black cherries and blackberries. Rich and flavorful on the full-bodied palate with dense, chewy tannins and a long, spiced finish. Big, opulent and pretty hedonistic in style. Slightly jammy, but not overdone. Garnacha tintorera. Try in 2025."
